Meeting attendance rules

- From the EC Standing Rules:
 - "Missing two meetings in a row (whether teleconference or face-to-face meetings) results in the loss of voting privileges in all JSR ballots and EC votes that have not yet started...
 - Missing five meetings in a row, or missing more than two-thirds of all meetings in any consecutive twelvemonth period, results in loss of EC membership.
 - The PMO shall provide regular attendance reports to the EC, and shall issue warnings to those who are at risk of losing membership.
 - Under exceptional circumstances, to be determined on a case-by-case basis, the EC may waive either of the above penalties."



The first 12 months

- The new Standing Rules came into effect on October 16 2012.
- During the first *consecutive twelve-month period* there will be 10 meetings: November, January, February, March, April, May, June, July, September, and October.
- Any member who misses seven of these meetings will forfeit their seat.


