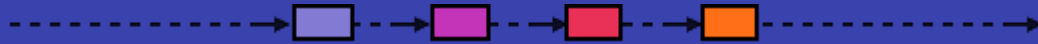

JCP.next Working Group report



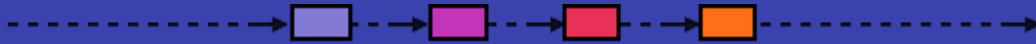
- Master List of proposed changes almost complete.
