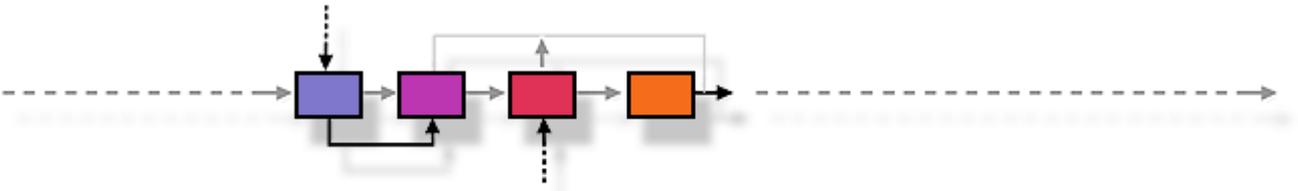

- The legal agreements are still working their way through Oracle's executive approval process.


