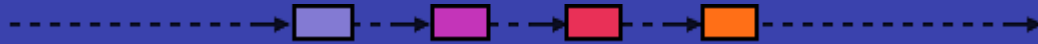

- 464 new membership agreements received since JCP 2.10 was introduced in May 2016.
  - 351 Associate Membership Agreements (27 were converted from individual full memberships).

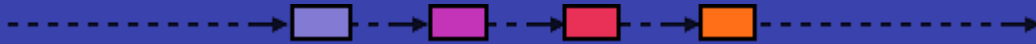

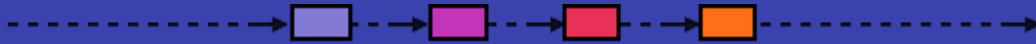

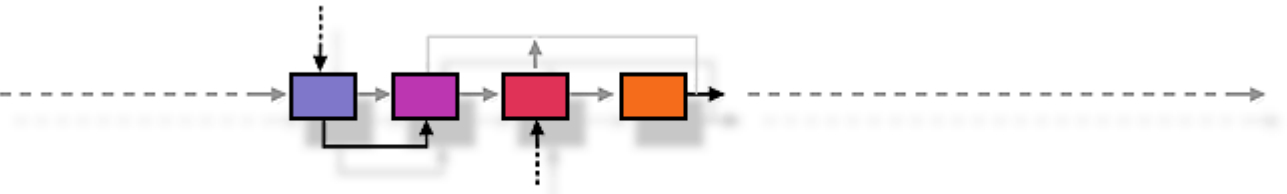
