The text should read: "Adding or removing <code>Players</code> or MIDI channels is not possible if any of the <code>Players</code> in the <code>Module</code> or the one being added is in <code>UNREALIZED</code>, <code>PREFETCHED</code> or <code>STARTED</code> state."</p> <p>The same change applies to several methods in the <code>Module</code> interface and the method descriptions need to be updated accordingly.</p>	<p>One of the disallowed Plaer states has not been mentioned in the specification.
